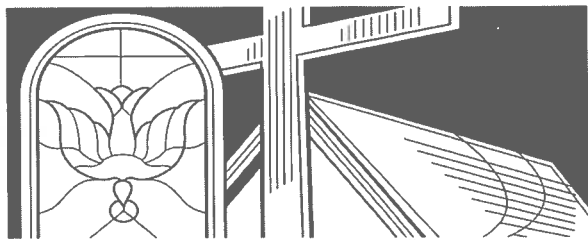

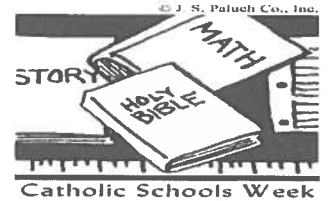

DID YOU KNOW?

Pornography Consuming Our Children

The largest consumers of Internet pornography are children between the ages of 12-17. More than half of boys and a third of girls have seen pornography before their teenage years. Thirty-five percent of young teenage boys (13-14 years old) say that they have seen pornography "more times than I can count." By the age of 18, more than nine out of 10 boys and six out of 10 girls have seen pornography online. The best defense against allowing pornography to reach our children is to stop it before it begins or to address it immediately.

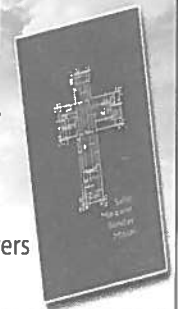
