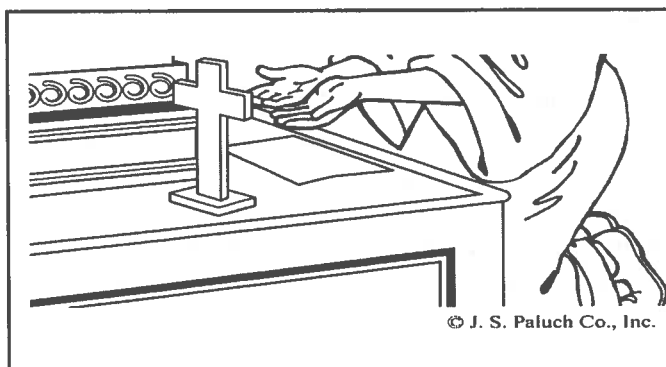

Religious Ed is in full swing this year with 294 children attending Tiny Tots, Preschool Sunday School, Elementary and Jr. High on Sunday mornings. Thank you for your patience in the parking lot and for looking out for our children and youth!!

We have 96 children/youth who will receive their sacraments of Reconciliation and 1st Communion in the coming spring. They and their parents are busy in preparation for the sacraments with parent meetings, classes and a retreat. Please keep them in your prayers!

Confirmation "Spirit and Life" for teens in high school is growing every year. Our sessions have begun and this year we have 84 youth in 1st Year Confirmation Prep and 91 in 2nd Year Confirmation Prep. Those 2nd year youth will be receiving their confirmation from Bishop Joseph Sartoris on May 24, 2015. We have already had our 1st Year Retreat held in Pomona at the Cursillo House. It was a great success - thank you to all the chaperones, kitchen crew, and Peer Ministry Team for working very hard to bring our faith to our young people.

2nd Year Retreat is scheduled for this weekend in the mountains above Santa Barbara at the St. Vincent de Paul Circle V Ranch. We ask that you keep all of our youth and those working this retreat in your prayers.

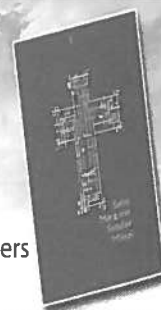

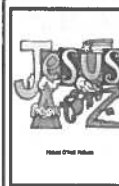

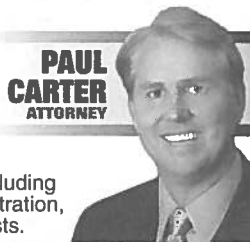
